- 1. By-Laws clarifications: Some clarifications may be needed to the by-laws regarding which board members may vote. - 7. Frontier Days: We will make the first push for volunteer workers for the bake sale at the July general meeting.

Smith stated that it is possible to print from the one we have. It was agreed that we not consider a new one for the time being.
- 9. PA system: We have a system to aid hearing disadvantaged members, and will try it out at the July general meerting.
- 10. Website: S. Copenhave not present, but did provide 2 DVDs for our review regarding current activities.
