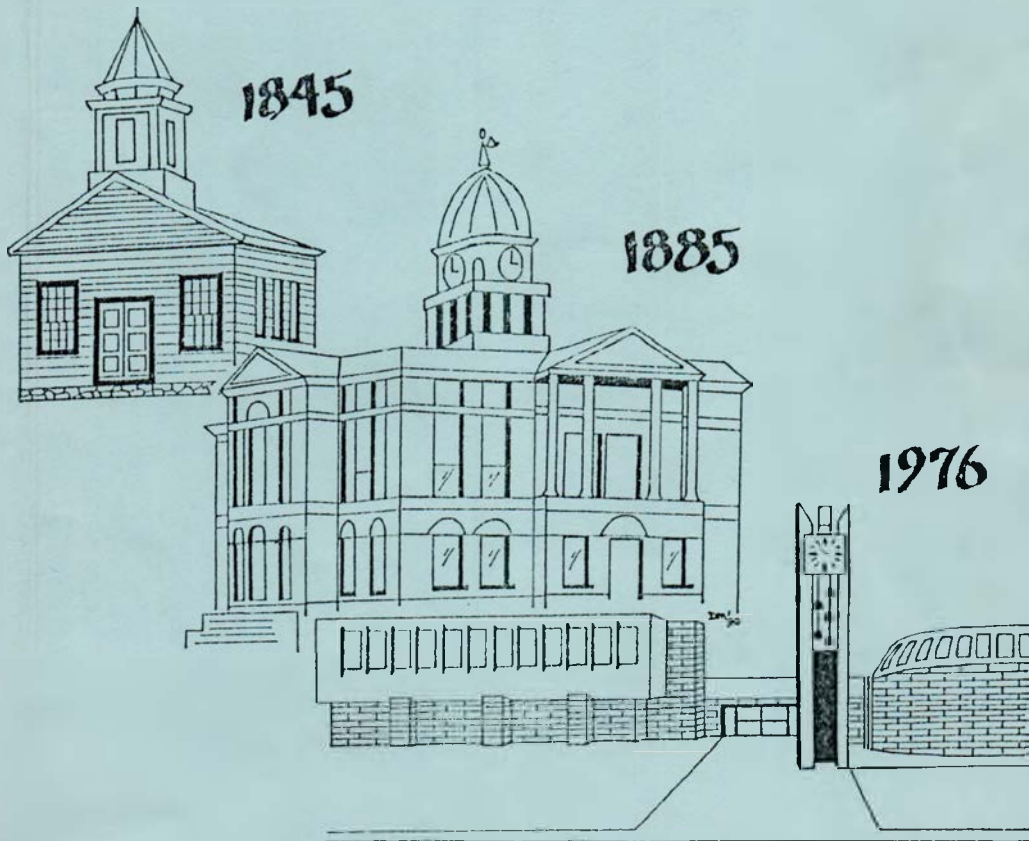

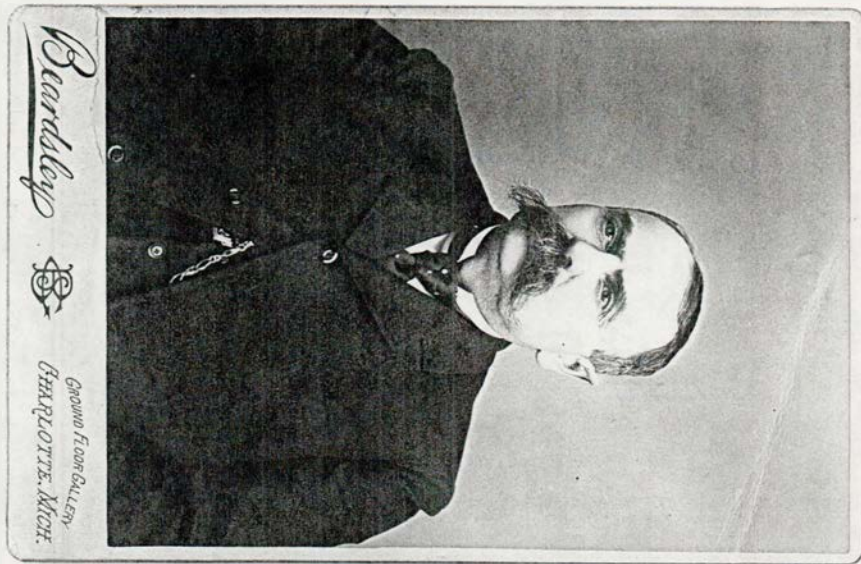

The following newspaper clipping is taken from a scrapbook in our room. The article is undated, published in the "Charlotte Republican-Tribune." (Article copied by Joyce Liepins, 9 August 1991)

CHARLOTTE LADY CAN TRACE HER ANCESTRY BACK TO YEAR OF 1099

Mrs. Belle Hawkins of 327 Prairie street can trace her ancestry back further probably than any other person residing in Charlotte. Her genealogy goes back to **Count Rudoff Waldron**, who as a brave knight of Holland assisted in the taking of the Holy City of Jerusalem from the Sacracens in A.D. 1099, in the first crusade by Christian powers against the Mohammedans. For his efforts he was awarded a coat of arms for his family, which was held sacred by his descendants as a patent of nobility.

Baron Resolved Waldron, born at Waldron Hall near old Harlem, Holland, was a legal descendant of **Count Rudoff Waldron**. He came to this country and served under Governor Peter Stuyvesant, last Dutch governor of New Netherland, from 1654 to 1664 in various capacities, as assistant fiscal, attorney general and lord desill, and as ambassador to the courts of New England, Virginia and Lord Baltimore, and by his influence saved the little colony of Delaware from being absorbed by Lord Baltimore into his colony of Maryland in 1658, when James, Duke of York, brother of King Charles the Second, of England, sent three ships of war to New Amsterdam and stole all the Dutch colonies in America and plastered his first title of York on the little city and the town of New York. Most of the best Holland families left the city, swearing they would not live under the British.

Baron R. Waldron then removed to his bowery on the east end of Manhattan island and called the place New Harlem after the old city in the Fatherland. The baron, for service rendered, was created

high sheriff of North Riding (all of Long Island) from 1664 to 1670. He died in Harlem in 1693, leaving eight children, of whom the youngest was **Samuel Nagle Waldron**, born September 5, 1670, in Harlem. Samuel married and settled at Horn's Hook at Waldron Hall, Harlem, N.Y. The third of his eight children was **Francis Bloodgood Waldron**, born in 1697, to whom Samuel gave his manor or bowery of 400 acres at Clover Hill, N.J., in 1831. A good dwelling house was erected there that year and it was still standing in 1887, then occupied by a great-grandson of Francis.

Among the several children of Francis was a son, **Francis J. Waldron**, born April 10, 1736, at Clover Hill. The first of several children of the latter was named **Samuel Waldron**, born August 11, 1762. Samuel married and had six children, some born in New Jersey and some in Ovid, Seneca county, N.Y. His last child was named for him, **Samuel Waldron**, born May 5, 1802. On February 23, 1823, he was married to **Dinah Coryell** of Ovid and they became the parents of 13 children. The ninth child, **Elizabeth M.**, was born December 9, 1835, and married **David J. Claus** of Otsego county, N.Y., July 4, 1855. They had three children, of whom the youngest daughter, now **Mrs. Belle Claus Hawkins**, born March 11, 1866, is the sole survivor of the family.

There are other descendants, however, of the Waldron family, in these parts. Among them are **Glenn D. Holiday**, of here, **Harold Miller** of near Olivet, **Mrs. Will Allen** of Partello, **Mark Holiday** of Lansing, and **Mrs. Roy Snow** of Urbandale, former Charlotte resident.

In a "fifty years ago" type of article, the 21 & 28 July 1905 issues of the "Charlotte Republican" newspaper reprinted the following article which was found in the 21 & 28 July 1855 issues of "Charlotte Republican."

Charlotte Republican- 28 July 1905:

"CHILD LOST IN CHESTER"

Fifty Dollars Reward Was Offered for the Recovery of a Girl.

Seen in a Swamp Near Mr. Zebulon Wheaton's in Chester Fifty Years Ago.

(Copied verbatim from Charlotte Republican of July 21, 1855)

The Wild Child Hunt in Chester

Charlotte has been considerably interested, and Chester the adjoining town north of us, quite excited by the report that a wild and unknown child had been seen a number of times in and near a swamp near **Mr. Zebulon Wheaton's**. The excitement and hunt has now lasted eight or nine days. Hand bills are out offering \$50 reward for the child. A large variety of stories are afloat-- some believe there must be a child there somewhere-- others pronounce it all a hoax-- and the whole of the surrounding country has made it the exciting topic of conversation and inquiry. Thus we feel bound to give such reliable particulars as we have been able to gather.

On Thursday of last week as the school children were on their way home at night from school, this child was first seen by them near a heap of stone which lies east of the school house in the **Wheaton district**. One of the girls called to a companion by the name of **Helen**, this child suddenly rose up from behind the stone heap answered "what" and with its hands raised came towards them. The children, frightened by the sudden appearance of the singular looking stranger, shunned its company and fled. They were followed by it a short distance until they reached a piece of woods or rather swamp, into which the child turned and disappeared.

They all described it as a white child--not an Indian or monkey--with long light hair, dressed in what seemed to have been once a light colored gown, but now very much torn and soiled and something that looked like an old sun bonnet on its head. It was bare footed, and apparently a little girl of seven or eight years of age.

On reaching their homes, the children related the story to their parents, who laughed and paid but little heed to it, until it was found that all of the children--some of whom were 11 or 12 years old--all had told their respective parents the same story, and that they all seemed quite excited by the event. Still, as there had been no report of a child having been lost, the story simply created wonder, and the children were told that the next time they saw it, they must either catch it, or coax it home with them.

On the next Saturday about half an hour before sun down, this child was again seen by **Mr. Wheaton's** and a number of other children, crossing an open field in the vicinity of the swamp. Part of the children started home to call their mother, (**Mrs. Wheaton**) that she might see it and be convinced, while another portion pursued it. The child fled from them with great speed, passing over the fences with remarkable agility, and again entering the swamp. One of the pursuers, a young lad, feeling determined to keep track of it, followed it a few rods into the swamp, when it stopped, turned around and looked at him. In one hand it held a handful of

blackberry briars, from which it now and then picked a berry and put into its mouth. As the boy advanced within about twelve feet of it, the child raised both of its hands in a menacing manner like a wild animal and gave him a wild inhuman look. The hour was gloomy and the place lonely, such a wild ferocious looking being in such a place caused the boy's courage to fail him, he turned and fled. He afterwards pointed out the precise spot where he and the child stood, which together with their tracks and the corroborating testimony of the other children convinced all in that vicinity, that the wild child was a reality.

This created an excitement in the neighborhood. And on the Sunday following- a large number of men turned out and searched the swamp. Though they did not find the child, yet they found evidence enough in the shape of foot-prints to convince them that quite a small child had been wandering alone in that wild unfrequented place. The swamp contains about forty acres, is quite wet and miry and rendered almost impassable by a dense growth of underbrush. There are roads on all sides of it and quite a number of cleared fields in its vicinity.

On Monday morning the school children again reported that they saw the child while on their way to school, near the place where it had been seen so often before. It had now been seen by about twenty children, and some of those children had each of them seen it three or four times. Word was sent down to Charlotte for assistance, and quite a number of citizens went up and passed the day in a fruitless search of the swamp. They returned with different opinions; some believing that it was a hoax got up by the children, others that a stray child had really been seen there. As to the manner in which the child came there, the prevailing opinion was, that it must have been intentionally left there by some one--probably movers--on or before Thursday; as it (evinced?) less wildness when first seen by the children than it did at any time later.

On Tuesday the excitement was started up afresh in this place, by a man coming down post haste from Chester, stating that the child was now positively known to be in the swamp, and calling for a large turnout of assistance. He said that the child had been seen and followed quite a distance by a man who succeeded in having a near and fair view of it. He first saw it on a log picking berries, and said it looked poor and much worried. As soon as it saw him it fled from him with great speed. He pursued with a fair prospect of overtaking it but just as they were entering the swamp he stumbled and fell down into the midst of a dense thicket. By the time he regained his footing he could neither see or hear anything of the child. They started out a large number of our citizens to join in the hunt. Full two hundred people were assembled on the ground. A line was formed with men within five paces of each other extending entirely across the swamp which swept slowly over the whole ground searching every hiding place. While sentinels were posted around the outside in such a manner that nothing could leave the place without being seen. But even this close search proved ineffectual and unsatisfactory; for a deer which was several times seen to be enclosed within the lines, made its escape; no one knew how. At night the child hunters who returned to this place (Charlotte) seemed well convinced that the child was there. Several remained on the ground during the night lest it might escape to some other forest, and arrangements were made for closely observing the place where the child had been seen to come after berries, early on the next morning.

Eight o'clock on Wednesday morning was set for all to meet at the home of **Zebulon Wheaton** for the purpose of reporting the discoveries of the night, and concerning the plan of operations for the day. Nothing was seen of the child on that day or during the next morning. On Wednesday a still larger number of people assembled. The swamp was repeatedly scoured by long lines of men walking closely together. A bounty of \$50.00 was offered for the child which **Mr. Lewis Noble** and **Wm. L. Lyon** of this place pledged themselves to see paid. But the day was oppressively warm, men were tired

out, and detained away from their suffering wheat fields, and other business. As they grew sick and tired of wallowing and shouting through that dismal swamp their faith began to stagger; several persons told the young man who had pursued it on the previous day, that they believed he lied. By Wednesday night the opinion that it was all a hoax or delusion was gaining ground quite rapidly especially among those who had joined most eagerly in the hunt.

Even those who still believed the story, came to the conclusion that the better way was to have a few men quietly lying in wait and watching the ground, instead of having two or three hundred constantly yelling and tearing through the bushes.

The hunt on Thursday was conducted more judiciously but without any satisfactory results, except finding what was believed to be the sleeping place of the child, a dry comfortable place, underneath the roots of a tree.

The most candid and judicious men, those who have carefully questioned the person who say they have seen it, have become firmly convinced that the child has been seen. The testimony of the young man who pursued it on Wednesday has been pretty well corroborated by those who saw him immediately after his return from the pursuit, as they visited the spot where he fell, and saw not only his track, but the tracks of a child and thus satisfied themselves that he had spoken the truth. Two or three of the scholars who saw the child are from twelve to sixteen years of age, and implicit reliance is placed in their truthfulness by those who know them. But neither the lost child or the losers of a child have yet been found. Yesterday morning an Indian somewhat noted for his sagacity and intelligence together with a half breed friend, hearing of the reward offered commenced a cautious and deliberate search for the wanderer on their own hook, they have not been seen or heard from since. The last report was that the child was seen yesterday two miles west of the swamp "away over by old Whatshisname's," but we have not been able to satisfy ourselves of its correctness. By next week we hope to be able to inform our readers whether this story of the lost child is a premeditated hoax, a childish delusion, or a sad reality.

(The following week, Fri. 28 July 1855, they followed up on the story with this article.)

WILD CHILD STILL LOST

Reported to Have Been Seen Near the Canadian Settlement in Oneida Township

This excitement has in a great measure died away in Chester, and the hunt has been abandoned, though public opinion, in regard to the foundations of the story is yet much divided. The child is reported to have been seen on Tuesday last about two miles west of Canada settlement in the town of Oneida, which is some seven or eight miles from the swamp where it was first seen. The people of the settlement seemed to have confidence in the report and were turning out for a hunt.

Instances of lost persons becoming entirely wild and eluding the vigilance of those in search of them with wonderfil adroitness, are not rare, but such persons have seldom wandered far from where they were first lost.

ROSE (MASON) SEARLES' AUTOGRAPH BOOK 1883-1889

Our treasurer, Mary Jean Baker, purchased an autograph book at an antique show in Hastings, Barry Co., MI on March 10, 1991. Mary Jean has kindly copied the entries for us to publish. In most cases, a flowery poem accompanies the autograph. Although the owner's name was given only as "Rose," research (based on clues found in the autographs) has indentified Rose as the wife of Howard E. Searles. Howard E. Searles, age 24, born Greene Co., N.Y., and Rose G. Mason, age 17, born ASHTABULA, OHIO (note the 17th autograph signed by Uncle Dave of Ashtabula, Ohio), both residents of Charlotte, were married in Charlotte on 28 April 1885 by Orange H. Spoor (Minister of the Gospel). The witnesses were Cora Collins (see autograph number 2) and Christopher Mason, both of Charlotte (Eaton Co. marriage records, vol. 5, page 116). Sadly, we learn that Rose died not many years later when we find her death record (vol. 2, page 462) stating she died 3 July 1892 in Charlotte, age 24y 7m 11d (rest of record is blank).

EDITOR'S COMMENTS:

This issue closes the first year of our quarterly publication. I have had a wonderful time putting these issues together for you, and I do hope you've had just as good a time while reading them.

The sources we have to draw from, in the Eaton County Genealogical Society's library, is endless, so the upcoming year will be just as exciting as the first. Our society has heard nothing but positive feedback from the readers, however, if you have a comment or a suggestion which you feel will improve the quarterly, we want to hear it. Tucked inside this issue is a questionnaire concerning the "Quest." We would appreciate all of you taking a few minutes to fill it out so we can see how we are doing. If you wish, you can remain anonymous. This is your chance to request the types of records you want to see published- or to straighten me out on something you see me doing wrong.

Besides the "Quest," our society has undergone dramatic changes. The material in our room is being organized in a fashion that will make it easier for you to access sources; we have purchased many new microfilms and books in the last nine months; our headquarters has expanded from the original room with accompanying vault, to two rooms and two vaults; we have doubled our membership in the last 9 months, from 72 members in November '90 to our approximate 145 members in August '91; one of our long-time dreams came true in July when we purchased a beautiful photocopy machine.

The mention of the photocopy machine allows me to explain the second form you find enclosed inside this issue. As all researchers agree, the necessity of having a copy machine at a library such as ours is paramount. The growth of our membership and the sales of our projects such as the cemetery series, our surname directory and our plat maps, plus two rummage sales, a genealogical book fair at the Civic Center in Lansing, and our annual genealogy workshop (whew!!), has allowed us to scrape up enough money to finally buy a copy machine. However, the cost was not cheap. After trying about 5 different demonstrators, we made our final selection- the MITA DC-1656- at a cost of \$2,392. This machine was superior in its ability to make an excellent photocopy from photographs as well as printed matter.

Because we did not have quite enough money to pay outright for the machine, we chose to go with a 2 year bank loan for \$2,000, with the intention of doing all we can to pay the loan off as quickly as possible. The machine is helping to pay for itself, as the money we collect from copies made (10¢) goes into a fund which is used to buy the toner, paper and pay for service calls, but that will probably leave a small portion going towards the loan payment. These payments will be paid from money we collect in membership dues and sales from our other publications, etc. The enclosed form is our request for any assistance you can afford towards our goal of paying off the machine. Believe it or not, if each of our 145 members donate just \$13.00, we would be able to pay the loan off right now! That would be a fantastic demonstration of support from our members! Because I'm a very optimistic person, I truly believe we can do it. I do realize that not every member can afford to make a donation at this time, but perhaps other members can donate more than \$13 and the difference will be made up that way. Even if you can give only \$1, it's going to count more than you realize, so send what ever amount you can. I've been very proud of the support our members have given this year, and I really believe I can count on you.
