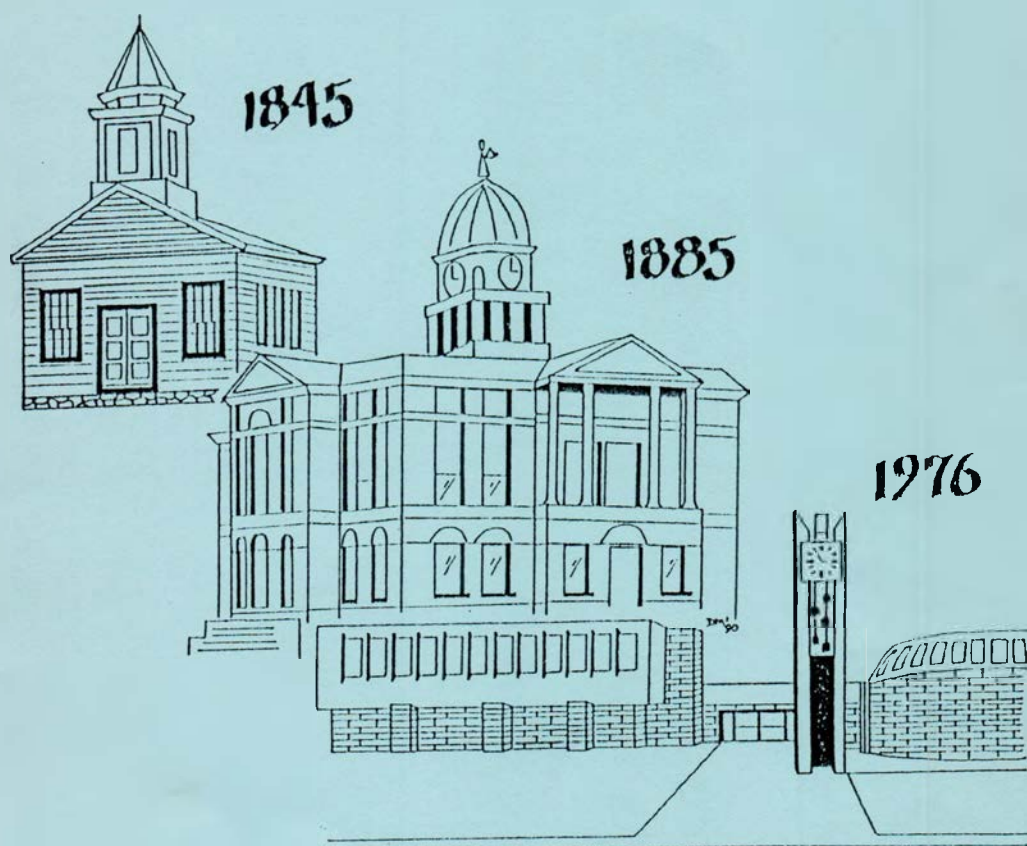

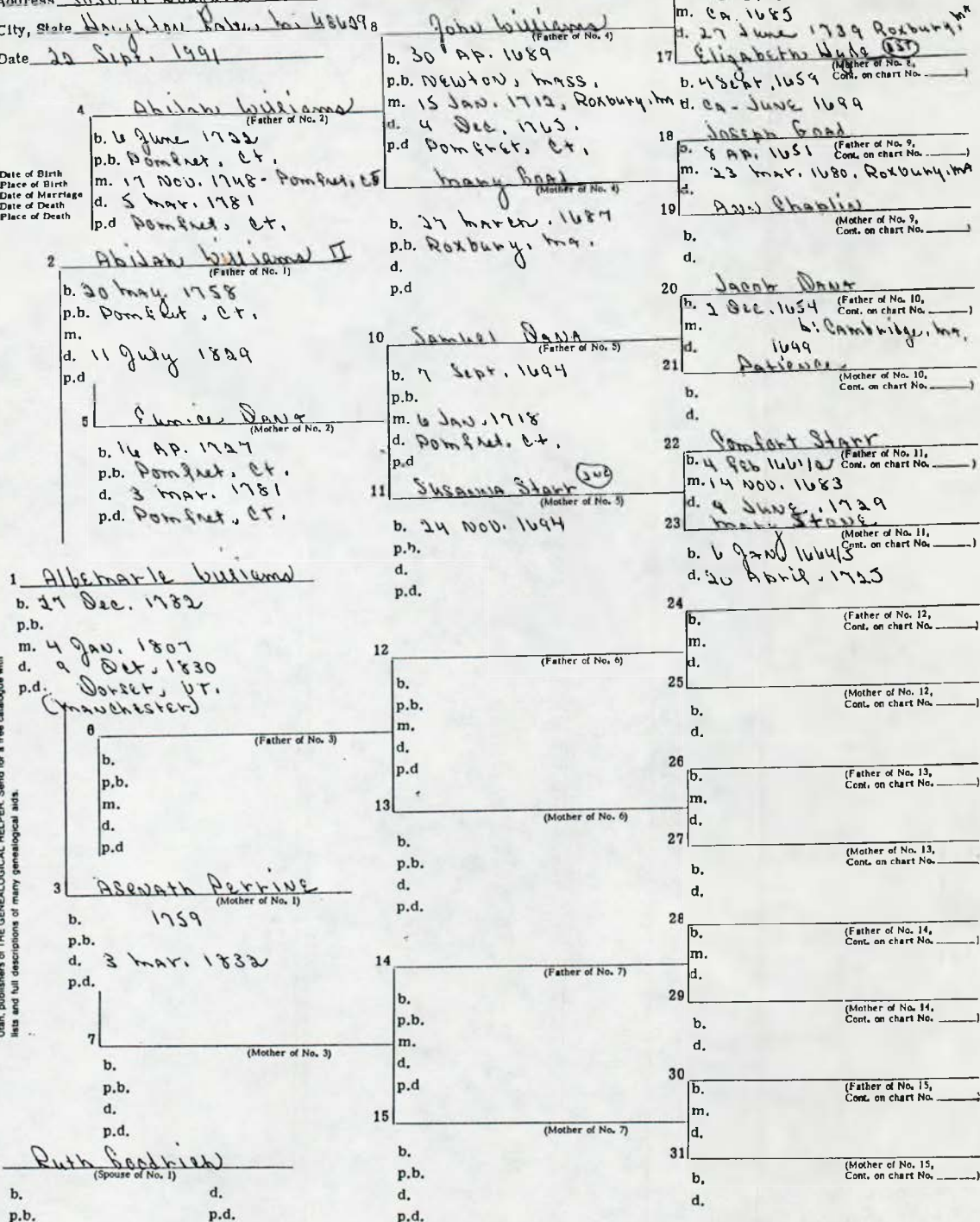

1993 Membership Renewals Coming Due

You will find your renewal form tucked inside this issue.

Accomplishments In 1992

As you know, our society had a goal of paying off our photocopy machine as quickly as possible. We are happy to report we achieved this goal!! We had a 24 month bank loan on the machine but were able to pay it off in September, just 14 months into the loan. A big THANKS goes to all our members who made this possible with their generous donations.

Our second accomplishment for the year of 1992 is the near completion of the work on the original probate records. We started with approximately 250 boxes of packets which had to be transferred from folded packets to flat folders and then name indexed. We are down to the last 50 boxes! We have been given a large vault on the basement floor of the courthouse and are in the process of installing shelves to accomodate the records. When the shelves are finished we will bring the records from their temporary storage to the basement vault.

Speakers Liven Up Our Meetings

Our society is bringing in speakers for our meetings whenever possible. At our June meeting, Shirley Hodges spoke on the subject of the little known 1880 federal census D-D-D schedule. Our September meeting brought Joe Pray from the Pray Funeral Home to discuss their record holdings. He also presented a slide show pertaining to unusual headstones.

Our meetings are held the 3rd Wednesday of every month at 7 p.m., except November's meeting which is held on the 2nd Wednesday of the month. We do not hold a meeting in December because of the holidays.

Mondays Are Work Bee Nights

Anyone who has some free time on Monday evenings is urged to come up and help us work on the probate packets. Someone is at our room to open at about 6 p.m. and we work until about 9 p.m. This ritual has been going on for most of the summer and we will continue as long as we have volunteers showing up to

work. As it is a tentative situation, you should call Drouscella Halsey (543-4135) or Joyce Liepins (645-2988) before 6 p.m. or the Courthouse (543-6999) after 6 p.m. before making the trip to the room. You may also use that evening to do research if you prefer. As many people work Wednesday daytime when our room is open to the public, it is impossible for them to use our facilities, so this will give you folks an opportunity to find the room open.

Funds Earned At Frontier Days

Our society sold pop, cookies, Domino's Pizza and coffee at the recent Charlotte Frontier Days event. Our profit from the 3 day sale was \$571.68. We intend to repeat this venture at the 1993 Frontier Days. We will be vending at several workshops this Fall to help raise money.

Another fundraiser will be the Arts & Crafts event to be held inside the 1885 Historic Courthouse on November 7th & 8th, 1992. We would like to make another call for you to send in your pedigree charts and perhaps family group sheets. You do not have to be a member to participate in this project. These charts and sheets will go into our pedigree file and the names will be indexed. A check of this index can put researchers of the same line in touch with each other. If you would like to see your pedigree chart published in one of the "Quest" issues, please include a note giving us permission to publish.

And Lastly.....

You will find two enclosures with this "Quest." One is our new brochure which also is your 1993 renewal form. The other is a form we would like all members to complete and send back to us. Although the form reads "citizen of Eaton County" we have checked into the wording and found it is not required that you be a citizen. As a member of our society which is housed in the 1885 Historic Courthouse you do have a serious interest in the well-being of the building and for the preservation of the collections (including much material in our library files). There is no immediate threat to the building but the Eaton County Historical Commission would like to be prepared with signatures of support should the old courthouse's future become "iffy."

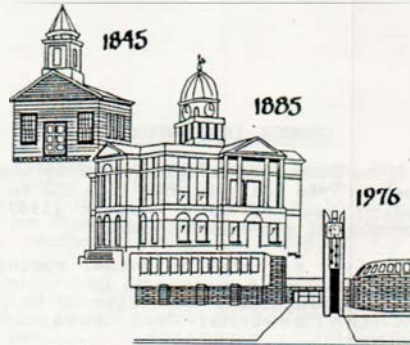

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Eaton County Genealogical Society was formed in 1988 and has grown from the few founding members to a current (1992) membership of approximately 150.

Our society sponsors an annual spring workshop whereby a variety of interesting speakers bring their expertise to help both the beginner and advanced genealogist.

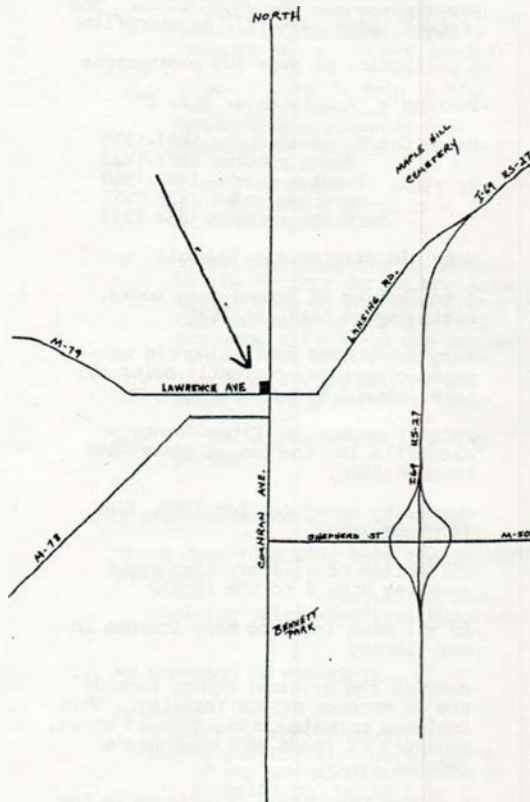
In 1976 Eaton County offices were moved from the downtown courthouse (now known as the 1885 Historic Courthouse) to the new complex located on Independence Blvd. Many of the county records which had been microfilmed were left in storage at the 1885 Historic Courthouse and our society has the use of these records. We also have purchased a collection of microfilm which includes all Eaton County federal census, the early Eaton County probate records, and the county marriage and death indexes and records. We have a growing collection on microfiche as well. Our photograph collection is always expanding. The files contain photos of early county landmarks, businesses and, of course, residents. One of our projects is collecting pedigree charts and family group sheets from our members and anyone who wants to submit these.

A new benefit enjoyed by our members is the ability to rent microfilms from the American Genealogical Lending Library (AGLL). Any member may take advantage of this service and can order census, passenger, military, etc., microfilms at our room. The newly released 1920 census is included in this rental program. In January of 1991 we sent out the premier issue of our quarterly magazine, the "Eaton County Quest." The issues contain never before published records of Eaton County, helpful pedigree charts sent in by readers, photographs from our files, and a query section. Each issue is approximately 50 pages of exciting material.

Our headquarters house a microfilm reader, 2 microfiche readers, and a photocopy machine (10¢ per copy). A microfilm printer is also available for our patron's use (25¢ per copy). The volunteer staff will be pleased to assist you in any way.

MINUTES OF THE EATON COUNTY GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY

September 16, 1992

The meeting was called to order by President Jeff Warren.

Minutes of the August meeting were distributed to attending members. Drouscella Halsey motioned to accept the minutes as presented. Joyce Liepins seconded the motion.

Treasurer Nancy Jourden's report was distributed to attending members. Income for August was \$138.21. Expenses were \$234.41. As of the end of August, our balance was \$742.55. The gross sales during Frontier Days was \$1,006.70. Our expenses were \$435.02, resulting in a net profit of \$571.68. Tomorrow the last payment will be made on the copy machine. Currently there is about \$1,100 in the checking account. Drouscella Halsey motioned to approve the Treasurer's report, Sheri Brown seconded the motion.

Corresponding Secretary Drouscella Halsey reported the following:

The speaker for our November meeting will be Scott Sanders. He will speak on wills and probate. Get your questions prepared for him; he will be available for about one hour.

Community Cash receipts have been sent in for \$45; we are waiting for the check.

About 50 boxes of probate packets remain unindexed in the attic. The number of volunteers has slacked off. We are still working on this on Monday nights.

We are in the market for lumber material for the shelf unit in the basement. Mr. Haigh is looking for used 36" doors to use instead of plywood. Mr. Haigh said he would like to add another 9 foot rack to the existing unit. Drouscella Halsey motioned that Mr. Haigh see if he can get another unit to use in the basement vault, up to \$150. Joyce Liepins seconded the motion. It was unanimously approved by the members.

Another vender is needed to help Drouscella at the Albion meeting. Sheri Brown said she would get back with her about helping.

New Business

An invitation was received from the Livingston County Genealogical Society to attend their November 7 event as a vendor. They will provide a complimentary table. It is the first Saturday in November. Nancy and Drouscella will vend. *14.00 per person.*

The genealogy room will be open November 7th during the craft sale in Charlotte.

"Christmas at the Courthouse" will be December 12-13. We are obligated to have the room open.

Speaker suggestions for the October meeting and the rest of the year are welcome. Jeannine Parker knows a delegate from Jackson, Elsie Campbell, who teaches classes and has been instrumental in the program for the help in the courthouse in Jackson.

Quest will be ready in about two weeks.

A SPECIAL LETTER TO OUR MEMBERS
15 October 1992

We enclosed a "Support The 1885 Courthouse, Jail Residence, and County Collections" form inside your "Quest" issue. We commented on this form under the "Miscellany Page" and said there was no immediate threat to the 1885 Courthouse at this time. **Unfortunately this situation has changed!**

At the same time we made that statement, we learned that Eaton County has been talking to a buyer for the 1885 Courthouse. The Eaton County Historical Commission, who is in charge of the care and preservation of this building, jumped right into action and is doing everything in its power to make sure the building is not sold.

Talks between the Historical Commission and the county have indicated that county funding will end January 1, 1994. The Eaton County Historical Commission will be submitting a proposal to the county sometime in November or December 1992 which will outline their plan to set up a foundation and to pursue all grants available for the maintenance and preservation of the old courthouse. The county may, or may not, accept this proposal. If we can show there is enough support, they may accept the proposal and allow the Historical Commission to use the time between now and January 1, 1994 to get the foundation and grants in place. If they succeed, the 1885 Courthouse will no longer be run by the county, but by a foundation. The entire courthouse square is currently going through the procedure of being submitted as a National Historic Site. This honor will not protect the buildings from being sold by the county should the Historical Commission fail in setting up a foundation and grants, but it would insure that the county has to find a buyer who will protect their facade.

The Historical Commission and our Genealogical Society has collected about 600 signatures from people like you who support the preservation of the two buildings on the courthouse square and the collections housed inside the 1885 Courthouse. Now that a real threat has surfaced, we need even more---we need to show the county that people are willing to give financial support as well.

We need donations from every place we can get them. **If the courthouse is sold to a private buyer, the Eaton County Genealogical Society loses its home.** While this is bad news in itself, even worse is that **we would also lose the use of thousands of original county books and papers that are being stored inside that building.** We can only guess at what the county intends to do with all this valuable material should the courthouse be sold. The likelihood is they they would be put it into storage, out of the reach of researchers like ourselves, or, perhaps even destroyed. Some of this material has never been microfilmed.

The bottom line is- while the Eaton County Historical Commission is doing all it can in the line of setting up a foundation and looking into grants, the citizens who are interested in these buildings and all the genealogical and historical material housed inside need to make themselves heard with their signatures, letters, and money. If you can send a donation to show your support, make your check out to the Eaton County Genealogical Society and we will present this money to the Eaton County Historical Commission with your forms and letters of protest and they will make them known to the county.

As was stated, the Historical Commission will be presenting their proposal to the county sometime in November or early December 1992, so we need to get as many donations and letters as we can by that time to show the county the kind of support that is out there. It may be the difference between the county accepting the proposal or denying it and going ahead with its plans to sell the 1885 courthouse. These donations and forms/letters will help convince the county to give the Historical Commission the year they need to save these important pieces of history.
