

These unique records were only recently recovered from the basement vault of the old 1871 Sheriff's Residence (located next to the 1885 Courthouse). It is not known how long they have been stored there, but we are very fortunate they have been recovered. Only the records for Kalamo Twp. have been found.

The special "Remarks" column gives us a rare glimpse into the life of the household. Although this column was not often filled in on the following certificates, when it was it lends the reader some valuable information.

To enhance the information contained in the following documents, the reader is advised to refer to issue #9 ECQ, page 21, where they will find an article which was published upon the discovery last year of a bundle of "relief checks" cashed by the families of these same soldiers. A history of the soldier's relief fund is also given in that issue.

These certificates are now in the library of the Eaton County Genealogical Society.

DOCUMENT FOUND IN OLD ALTRUISTIC CLUB OF CHARLOTTE RECORDS:

This agreement made and entered into this 27th day of January, A.D. 1914, between the Altruistic Club of the city of Charlotte, Eaton Co., Michigan, by its president and secretary party of the first part, and the Charlotte Sanitarium by its President, Secretary and treasurer, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

That in consideration of the payment of the sum of four dollars per week, payable at the end ("first" penciled in) of each month, which the party of the first part hereby agrees to pay, the party of the second part hereby agrees to let and lease, provide and maintain with necessary and proper heat, light, care, etc., a room No._____ in the Sanitarium of said second party at Charlotte, Michigan, for the use of any indigent person or persons who shall or may be placed in or taken to said Sanitarium by the proper officer or agent of said first party.

Said second party further hereby agrees to furnish all necessary care, nursing, medical aid and attendance for such indigent persons at the rate of seven dollars per week for ordinary cases as shall be

taken to said Sanitarium by the proper officers or agents of said first party, which charge the first party hereby agrees to pay; it being further agreed that said charge shall cover all the expenses for medical aid and attendance, care and nursing of such indigent person over and above the rental of four dollars per week for said room, unless a special agreement or arrangement for a larger charge shall be made with the proper officer of said first party.

It is further mutually agreed that this contract shall continue in full force for the term of six months from and after this date, and that the same may be renewed from time to time by mutual agreement, and further that if said room is at any time occupied by any patient at said Sanitarium not sent there by the proper officer or agent of said first party, then said first party shall have credit for the amount received by said second party for the use of said room during such occupancy; and further, that said first party shall have the right at the termination of this lease or when said first party shall cease to hold said room under this agreement, to remove from said room all furniture, bedding and things placed there by it, for use during the term of this lease.







This book contains the descendants of Sanford Stevens (1793-1872) of Connecticut, Tompkins County, New York and Crawford County, Pennsylvania, and his wife Sally (Stevens) Stevens (1795-1876), and also traces the ancestors of Sally. It is the result of twenty years of research.

Sanford, whose parents remain a mystery, was born 2 Feb 1793 in Connecticut. On 22 Sep 1811, he married Sally Stevens. She was born 14 Jun 1795 in Connecticut and was the daughter of William and Huldah (Dann) Stevens. They were married 60 years and became the parents of thirteen children who lived to maturity. This genealogy includes the descendants of the twelve oldest children.

The book has many stunning photographs of the family members, is well-documented, and easy to read. There are several Eaton County families to be found within the pages, which should peak the interest of our readers.
