

It is important that we do not overlook the value of putting queries on message boards. We have to face the possibility that we might never hear anything from these queries but oftentimes they bring great results. I like to think of them as putting a message in a bottle and throwing it into the ocean. It might come to rest in exactly the right place and find the right person. I personally believe that most of our greatest genealogical finds are because of divine intervention. I look at answers to these queries in that light.

About twelve years ago I placed a number of queries on several different boards. One of the families I was looking for was **Charles Welch** who married **Abigail Chase**. The family had moved from Vermont to New York then on to Fulton County, Ohio with some of the family moving on to Michigan. I received a reply back to one of those queries about six years ago from a wonderful lady by the name of **Vivian Russell**. I knew from her response that she and my husband were related. I sent a reply back and told her that my husband would like to talk with her. She called a few days later and we had a delightful conversation. At the end of the conversation as she was getting ready to hang up she said, "well dear, you do know that there is a **Welch** reunion this week-end in Michigan, don't you?" We did not know about the reunion. **Vivian** said she was coming up from her home in Florida and would love to meet us there. We went to the reunion and my husband met 65 new cousins who have all become very dear friends. This was all because of a query that took me ten minutes to write and post.

Take time to go to these message boards. Do a quick search and see if anyone else is searching for the same people that you are. You may find a relative who will be happy to share and exchange information with you.

The Dolson Automobile

The Dolson Automobile, which was built in Charlotte shortly after the turn of the century, was one of the early pioneer cars to be introduced to the American public. The factory where the Dolson cars were built still stands in Charlotte at the southwest corner of West Lovett and Pearl Streets. It is a three-story brick building standing very near to the Grand Trunk Railway. A railroad siding was extended to the factory, thereby establishing easy access for shipping the finished automobiles to their ultimate destination. At that time, the regular railroad boxcars were used for this purpose.


The actual construction of the Dolson car was begun in 1903, with road-testing of the cars being conducted on country roads adjacent to the city of Charlotte. The earliest Dolson cars were designed to carry four passengers, including the driver. One of the first Dolsons was built with a door in the back of the car body through which the passengers to the back seat would enter the vehicle. Later, the design was changed to side-entry doors. The engine for the Dolson was a 2-cylinder motor manufactured by the Buick Motor Car Company of Flint.

The cars were widely advertised and promoted in various automobile magazines. They were always displayed at both the New York and Chicago Automobile Shows.

During the great San Francisco Earthquake on April 18, 1906, in which 452 people lost their lives, the Dolson car played an important part in the rescue operations. The Dolson Automobile Agency had a number of cards on hand in its stock and these cars were taken, under police and military authority, for relief work. In a letter to the Dolson Car Company from Mr. H. W. Laugenour, manager of the San Francisco Agency, he commented on their quality and performance, vividly describing how invaluable their cars had been in the rescue efforts. The letter was published in the Charlotte Republican-Tribune of May 25, 1906. The cars hauled tents and poles to make shelters, and other necessities to relieve the suffering of the earthquake victims.

The Dolson Company was declared bankrupt by the United States Court in Grand Rapids, by the middle of 1907.

The building was taken over by the Duplex Power Car Company, which produced 4-wheel drive trucks in Charlotte for about six years. In 1916, the Duplex Company moved its operation to Lansing. A short time later, the building was purchased by the Charlotte Chair Company.

The John Dolson Story Research by Mary Jean Baker

John L. Dolson came from Indian in 1864 to Charlotte. He had learned the blacksmith trade as a youth, and put his talent to work at a job repairing wagons and carriages. He became acquainted with **George Ward**, who was in the same line of business. In 1871 they formed a partnership and went into the business building carriages and sleighs under the name of **Ward and Dolson**.

The business prospered until 1888, when shortly after a plant expansion, **George Ward** decided to sell his share to a man named **May**. The business then became known as **Dolson and May**. A year later **John Dolson** sold out to a man named **Barney** and again the name was changed. **Dolson** remained with the firm as a salesman.

John Dolson started working on a new road wagon, which he planned to manufacture with his sons. Construction of a new building was started early in 1890 at the corner of Lovett and Pearl streets in Charlotte. By December 1890 a sample road wagon was built and the first shipment left the factory January 3, 1891.

The Dolson Automobile

The three stories, 50 feet by 250 feet building enabled the **Dolsons** to produce 4,000 to 5,000 carriages a year, with a crew of 100 to 125 workmen. As many as 26 of these employees were blacksmiths who labored at their forges in the basement, forming carriage parts.

There were over 100 carriage manufacturers in the state of Michigan at that time, and the **Dolsons** were by no means the largest. That honor belonged to **Durant and Dort Co.** of Flint.

At least one **Dolson Carriage** is in existence today. It was bought at a farm auction by the **Kitsloar Carriage House**, a furniture store in Green Bay, Wisconsin, and restored to be used as an advertising symbol of their business. There is another known one that the Historical Commission wanted to purchase but didn't have the funds. It was in Florida the last I heard.

FILE FAMILY HISTORY

Arranged by Mary Jean Baker

One of our members, **Martha Raths**, has a friend **Cora** who lived in Charlotte during the years she grew up. She made a family notebook, which Martha shared with us. I have taken parts of it to share, plus looked up more **File Family** information.

In the 1939Sanitary Survey of Charlotte, the **File** grandparents' home was at 323 S. Horatio. It was an eleven room house with electricity but no telephone at the time. They owned 20 hens, which indicate that they sold eggs.

Deeds show that **Fred & DeEtta File** bought the house January 13, 1902 for \$1200.00. Both having died in 1943, the heirs were their three children: **Harold** (wife Mabel), Lawrence (Betty and siblings' father, then "single"), and Margaret File Lauritzen. The house at 323 Horatio was "quitclaimed" to Leora G. Allen of 221 ½ Henry Street (just around the corner) for \$1.00 and other considerations".

Later, it stood vacant for some time. High school kids used it as a teen hangout, supervised, of course. They cleaned and painted some rooms inside, had pool tables, ping-pong etc. The rooms were big with high ceilings, and had beautiful, dark woodwork. At some point the High School bought the house. Sometime in the late 1960s it was torn down for a school parking lot.

In 1973 two of the **File** children set up a business in Charlotte in the old "**Colizzi's Candy/Soda Shop**" after they retired. They had to use an ice scraper to get the ground-in candy off the floor in the candy-cook room.

PT-19B "Cornell" Training Plane to be Purchased From Bond Drive

(March 2, 1944 High School Newspaper - "Orange & Black"

A Grand total of \$48,018.60 worth of bonds and stamps was purchased during the recent 4th war loan drive, which ended Feb. 15. The amount of \$1,118.60 worth of stamps and \$46,900.00 worth of bonds was purchased. The goal set for the campaign was \$15,000 in order to have the Charlotte school system's name engraved on a PT-19B 'Cornell' training plane. The schools here in the city all combined tripled these aims.

The teachers selling \$1,000 and over of bonds were **Mable Gildart**, Froebel school, \$9,200; **Rose Whidden**, Hawthorne school, \$5,250; **Catherine Crozier**, junior high, \$4,300; **Zella Hallifax**, high school, \$3,700, **Ailleen Lipsey**, high school, \$3,375; **Elizabeth Bradley**, Hawthorne, \$2,735 and others were **Leiella Barnes**, **Marie Taylor**, **Richard Bilbie**, **Dorotha Jenson**, **Nina Shotwell**, **Jean Slowey and Wendell Anderson**.

Early Members of the Charlotte Fire Department

Early Members of the Charlotte Fire Department

Information from a 1959 Michigan State Firemen's Association State Convention booklet and minutes of Charlotte City Council meetings.

On October 8, 1872, the Charlotte, Michigan Fire Department was officially organized with 40 members. The Fire chief was Doctor Samuel Perky. The First Assistant Engineer was Ben J. Grier, the Second Assistant Engineer was Sam Ketcham, and the Foreman was L.H. Turner.

The members of the department in 1877 were W.J. Bonnett, Chief Engineer; Samuel Pollock, First Assistant Engineer; J.W. Rogers, Second Assistant Engineer; HH. Wilson, Secretary; John Mitchell, treasurer; George Rawley, engineer; Uri Prindle, stoker; John Hite and Issac Bottomly, pipemen; and Harry E. Roers and George Bradley, assistant pipemen. The other members of the department that year were Josh B. Krebs, O.G. Young, George Stoner, P.B Frace, Soloman Fisher, J. Welch, L.A. Cooper, John B. Krebs, James House, M. Belger, Wm. Davis, James Ploof, W.H. Perkins, E. Pitcher, A. Judd, M. Grott, J. VanJohnson, W.A. Fields, Levi Woolston, and Bert Rogers.

In March 1879, the city purchased a No. 3 Silsby Steam Fire Engine with 1,000 feet of hose and coupling, etc., for \$6,251.50. The water supply came from reservoirs located at street intersections and in the alleys of the business district.

After the purchase of the steam fire engine and heavier equipment it became necessary to call horses into service to haul the equipment over the rough dirt streets. For many years there was an agreement with the many livery stables and dray barns located about the business district that when the fire bell was sounded the first team of horses and driver to arrive would pull the fire engine to the fire and receive \$2.00 for the job. During the winter months, bob sleds were used to some extent.

By 1880, with J.V. Johnson chief, the department consisted of the following companies:

Charlotte Hose Company, No. 1, twenty-four members. - W. Field, Foreman and F.E. VanHoughton, First Assistant Foreman.

Active Hose Company, No. 2, thirty-five members. - C.E.K. Baxter, Foreman; A.B. Bretz, First Assistant; and William Munson, Second Assistant.

Prairie Queen Hook-and -Ladder Company, No. 3, thirty-seven members -George Wright, Foreman; Will Fredericks, First Assistant; and F.H. Newlon, Second Assistant.

In 1888, Charlotte installed water works and steam driven pumps. The water works building was located on South Cochran Avenue on the banks of the Battle Creek where the 1845 Eaton County Courthouse now stands.

On April 24 1899, the common council of the city of Charlotte approved the following officers of the fire department: Chief, Dennis J. Donovan; Captain, W. J. Newlon, Lieutenant, Ed Lynd; Secretary, E. Benson Collins; Treasurer, Samuel Robinson, Jr.; and Sergeants-at-Arms, James Dell and Chas. V. Lane.

Village of Bellevue

Founded in 1833 along the Battle Creek River, Bellevue was the first settlement in Eaton County. Named for the "beautiful view" observed by early settlers, Bellevue reflects the quiet pleasant life of small town America.

Bellevue can boast of many "firsts", including the first non-native American born in Eaton County, the first church service, the first school, the first post office and the first to begin a limestone quarry business.

The Village has several monuments to honor its historic past, which are listed in the Michigan State Histories Division and in the National Historic Registry. They include the Dyer Limestone Kiln and park, the old four mill, the cut stone Village Hall and several homes in the Village, which are listed on the State Register of Historic Homes.

BELLEVUE LIBRARY HISTORY

For as long as anyone remembers, there has been a Bellevue Township Library. According to the clerk's Record Book of 1849-1874, which contained the minutes of the Township Board Meetings, various purchases were made for the library and the first documented librarian.

The first librarian, **George S. Avery**, served from 1849-1850. During this time period the exact location of the library is unknown. It is believed to have been located in what was called the **Old Engine House** after 1883.

The engine house was also the city hall at the time, as well as the jailhouse. It

was located in **Washington Park** on the corner of Main and Mill. During this period, the clerk's record book refers to the "library room" where most of the Township Meetings were held.

Other supporting evidence concern the rent, which was paid to **Mr. A. E. Fitzgerald** to the sum of \$35 a year for rent of the library room. He was to furnish the room in its good condition, as well as fuel and oil. The tax assay for the year 1900 show **Mr. Fitzgerald** as owning a store located on the S. W. corner of block 48 (north of hotel).

Two other people were also paid rent for the library rooms but their property could not be documented. **W. C. Lloyd** was paid \$8 a month from 1923-1926 and after 1926 **W. H. Harrison** was paid the same wage.

In 1907, the Township Board voted to elect Mrs. J. F. (Alice) Sackett as librarian. She was the librarian until 1937 when her daughter, Theata Babcock, took her place. She was employed as librarian longer than anyone else before or since. During the years

Mrs. Sackett's wages ranged from six dollars a month to \$17-21 a month before the depression when her wages were cut back to \$6 a month.

After the Township Board purchased the existing Municipal Hall from the Farmer's State Bank in 1934, the old engine house was torn down and the offices of the Village and Township clerks were moved to the first floor of the old band and the library moved to the second floor.

The New Library Building

After the death of Mrs. Edna Carroll, her husband Oliver Carroll purchased the existing building, which now holds the library, from Mr. John Hutchings and donated it in Mrs. Carroll's memory. Renovations concerning the building's front and interior were made and the library was officially moved from the Municipal Hall in 1971. It opened on August 28, 1971. The library now functions in conjunction with the Township and the Bellevue Historical Society Museum located next door.

Village of Mulliken

The beginnings of Mulliken are sketchy, but it is known that it developed because of the railroad.

Chester Miller's Diary states: "Mulliken was known as North Hoytville. John Mulliken, the general manager of the Detroit, Lansing and Northern Railway Co., convinced a handful of residents to rename the town after him. In return, he would purchase a bell for the church. To the church members, it seemed appropriate to rename North Hoytville to Mulliken. It enraged the people of Hoytville and those not attending church."

Several businesses and factories were platted out between North Hoytville and Hoytville. Lots were being sold after renaming the village. Disagreements brought about hard feelings and bitterness. People wouldn't work together, so businesses went elsewhere. Dreams in the minds of the originators never materialized.

Most of the land occupied by Mulliken was originally owned by T. E. Potter, Syvanus Peabody and Aaron French. Mr. Peabody donated sites for the church and parsonage and dedicated the church, which was originally a United Brethren Church. It later became a Congregational Church and finally a Methodist Church.

The first store in Mulliken was a grocery store, moved from Hoytville by **Byron Whepley.** A flourishing logging business was started by **Harris Jones.** Brick and soft tile were manufactured in Mulliken. A feed mill was built and is now the elevator.

At one time, Mulliken had two weekly newspapers. The Mulliken News was established in July, 1897, with **S. J. Jacobs** as editor and **W. J. Fish** as publisher. The Express was edited by **Filo Rogers.**

During school vacation in 1909, a tornado took a side out of the Mulliken School. The hotel burned around 1910.

Mulliken at one time was a self-sufficient village providing for its citizens a place to live and earn a living. Most of today's residents work and participate in activities elsewhere.

All the students are identified in this photo taken of the Wheaton School for the 1919-1920 school years. I've decided to find out more information on the students. The report will be on students as shown from left to right -

<u>Arthur Drake</u> – He was born Arthur Evander Drake on 20 July 1898 in Delta Township. His father was Fred Woodard Drake and his mother was Melvina Slaughter. Fred was a builder. At the time Arthur Drake applied for his delayed birth record in 1939, he was living in Settle, King County, Washington.

<u>Mvrle Wheaton</u> - He was born March 30, 1908 and died October 13, 1986. On his funeral card it shows the following as casket bearers: **Donald Hale, Norman Wilmore, Gerald DePue, Verle Stall, Dewayne Wright and Dorwin Schultz.** (Funeral Card)

It did considerable damage, however no serious injuries to the family. The children were caught running from the barn to the house. Mrs. Wheaton's oldest son Phil Wheaton, grabbed onto a big tree in the year and when the tree was blown down he hung on and escaped with no injury. The other two children, Stanley & Janet Wheaton, were hit with flying debris from the back of the house and woodshed, and barely escaped serious injury. They had only cuts and bruises. A big window was blown out of the front of the house, furnishings were damaged some, but the main part of the house escaped serious damage. (Tales Along Clinton Trail 1989, page 30)

FOREIGN DEATHS

Okay, you ask, "What are Foreign Deaths?"

They are deaths that occurred outside of the county in which the person was living. For example, someone from Eaton County dies in a Lansing (Ingham Co.) Hospital and is buried back in Eaton County. The death record will be made in Ingham County, but a copy sent to Eaton County and put in the foreign deaths drawer at the Eaton County Courthouse. I believe they have them back to the 1950s. Our genealogy library has copies of foreign deaths from 1991 forward.

DELAYED BIRTHS

Years ago babies were born at home and so they never had birth certificates made. When Social Security came into use, during the 1930s, workers needed birth certificates. They were able to apply for a "Delayed Birth Record" in order to prove their birth so they could claim Social Security benefits.

EARLY MARRIAGE RETURNS

These records are on film in the genealogy library and are hand-written early marriages recorded before they were kept by the county. The film is not indexed so it takes a lot of searching to find what you are looking for, unless you have a date to work with.

OWENS-ILLINOIS GLASS FACTORY

With news of the Owens-Illinois factory closing this spring, I looked up the history of this glass factory in Charlotte.

When **Wilcox-Gay**, makers of recorders', left Charlotte in the early 1960s, the business leaders of Charlotte were trying to fill the void, which left several hundred people unemployed. It seemed like a dream come true when **Owens-Illinois**, a manufacturer of glass containers, built a plant on a 71-acre site on Packard Highway. The new plant was a modern, highly automated operation, making bottles and jars from raw materials, which were automatically measured, mixed, melted, and molded.

In 1963 employees ranged from 300 to 1,000 with an annual payroll of \$2 million. The employment was at 900 by 1978.

Three mammoth glass furnaces were pouring out glass in a round-the-clock operation. The huge warehouse was filled with bottles, with a high proportion of them being for the **Stroh Brewery**.

A drastic change came about in the glass container industry when Michigan enacted the **Bottle Ban** law in 1978. Beverage bottle production was greatly reduced. A major portion later was with the **Gerber Baby Food Company**, along with **Prego Spaghetti and Vlasic Pickles** as customers.
